### 9:30 GENERAL SESSION

Legal Requirements for Airports and Their Transportation Providers

The regulatory environment for airport ground transportation operations is constantly changing. Local ordinances, state mandates, and new federal laws dealing with interstate transportation constantly challenge the operation of the airport curb. The Real Interstate Drivers Equity (RIDE) Act of 2002 is being interpreted, by some, as a law that forbids airports to make any charges for interstate providers. Local and state regulations regarding open entry taxi and van operations are challenging the airport concept of a concessioned ground transportation system. State employment divisions are challenging the use of independent contractor drivers in the taxi, limousine, and shuttle van industry. Regional energy proponents are urging airport officials to permit only alternative fuel fleet vehicles on their curbs. Finally, American with Disabilities (ADA) proponents are pushing for greater use of wheelchair-capable vehicles in taxi and van operations. These and other regulatory issues will be the focus of the opening session.
